

iPhone/iPod Touch

Wallpaper and Backgrounds

First browse ThemeMyPhone and save all of your wallpapers to a folder. You can call it something like "iphone-wallpapers".

In iTunes do the following:

1. Click the Photos tab and select "Sync photos from:"
2. From the pop-up menu, do the following:
3. Choose the iphone-wallpapers folder, or which ever folder you have saved the iPhone wallpapers too.
4. You can then choose "All photos," or choose "Selected folders" or "Selected albums" and choose the folders or albums you want to sync.
5. Then from your iPhone go to: Settings --> Wallpaper --> Photo Library and then choose which iPhone wallpaper you would like to set. Thats it!

iPhone/iPod Touch

Themes

First thing, is that your iPhone and or iPod touch should be jail broken with Installer.app installed.

1. Install BSD subsystem (from list of apps available from Installer)
2. Install OpenSSH (from list of apps available from Installer)
3. Get a SFTP program to SSH to your iPhone from your computer Try FuGu or Transmit.

4. SFTP settings: Server will be your IP address of your iPhone, User = root, password = dottie or alpine. (get your iPhones IP address from Settings->Wifi->click the arrow next to the wifi network you are connected to. you'll then see your IP address)
5. Summerboard themes go in Library/SummerBoard/Themes/ , this is the directory you'll place your themes. each theme should have it's own folder.

Video Wallpaper

First, download the vWallpaper app for your iPhone.

1. Move the .mov (vWallpaper) file to /private/var/mobile/media/skrew/videos

Dock Bar

Make sure you have SummerBoard installed.

If you don't have a theme already installed then follow these instructions.

1. Create a folder called "Dock" and move the dock bar into the folder.
2. Rename the dock bar Dock.png
3. Move folder to /var/root/Library/SummerBoard/Themes/

If you already have a theme installed then follow these instructions.

1. Rename the dock bar "Dock.png"
2. Move the dock bar into your theme folder
example: /var/root/Library/SummerBoard/Themes/PirateTheme

iPhone/iPod Touch

Icons

1. Drop it in the specific application folder.

iPhone/iPod Touch

Battery Icons

You will need the application, "Customize" in order to change your battery icons.

1. Place all files in the following path on your iPhone: private/var/root/library/customize/BatteryImages/ "Pick any folder name"
2. The folder is one that you have to create yourself.
3. Then place all the files in that folder.

Carrier Logos

You will need the application, "Customize" in order to change your carrier logo.

1. Extract and copy folder to Library/Customize/CarrierImages.

Signal Bars

1. Extract and copy folder to /System/Library/CoreServices/SpringBoard.app/

WiFi Icons

1. Extract and copy folder to /System/Library/CoreServices/SpringBoard.app/

iPhone/iPod Touch

Status Bars

Make sure you have SummerBoard installed.

If you don't have a theme already installed then follow these instructions.

1. Create a folder called "StatusBar" and move the status bar into the folder.
2. Rename the status bar "StatusBar.png"
3. Move folder to /var/root/Library/SummerBoard/Themes/

If you already have a theme installed then follow these instructions.

1. Rename the status bar "StatusBar.png"
2. Move the status bar into your theme folder
example: /var/root/Library/SummerBoard/Themes/PirateTheme

iPhone/iPod Touch

SMS/Email Badges

There are two ways to do it, via customize or in springboard folder.

1. Customize
/private/var/root/library/customize/badgeimage
Move badge to this folder
2. Springboard
/System/Library/CoreServices/Springboard.app
Change file SBBadgeBG.png

iPhone/iPod Touch

Sliders

You will need the application, "Customize" in order to change your Slider.

1. Place the Slider folder in root/Library/Customize/MainSliderImages

iPhone

Ringtones

Once you have saved your ringtones to your computer, there is a programs which lets you add new ringtones to your iPhone.

1. On a Mac, there is a program called iToner in which you can transfer the ringtones to your iPhone.
